

Grades & Ratings

FIDE Ratings from the April 2014 list will be used for this event, whilst ECF grades published in the January 2014 list will be used for unrated players based on $FIDE = ECF * 8 + 600$

The Championship will be both FIDE rated and ECF graded.

Ungraded Players

Players without a current FIDE rating or ECF grade must give details of estimated playing strength, including any previously held grading, or current grading from another body. Ungraded or unrated players may not win a grading prize.

Notices

The controller reserves the right to transfer players between tournaments at any time. Prizes may be amended subject to numbers of entries. English players must be Gold members of the ECF. Pairings in all sections will be made according to FIDE swiss pairing rules using the Swiss Master computer program. All games will be played using DGT digital clocks. No player may win more than one prize. The submission of an entry form and payment of the entry fee is acceptance that the controller's decision is final in all matters. How to get there



By Car:

Exit M25 at Junction 13,

At the roundabout take the exit signposted Bagshot (A30), which runs alongside the slip-road back up to the M25. At the next roundabout take the second exit on to the A30 towards Bagshot / Camberley. At the next roundabout take the second exit (A30). Follow the road straight over the first and second set of traffic lights and at the third set of lights turn right onto Blacknest Road (A329). Follow this road for approximately 2 miles before turning left onto Silwood Road (B383), signposted to Sunningdale Park * then take the first right into Larch Avenue and after a short distance Sunningdale Park's main entrance is on your left.

Exit M4 at Junction 10

Take the exit signposted A329 Wokingham. Then take the A329M towards Bracknell. From Bracknell follow the A329 for approximately 8 miles. Go through Ascot and towards Virginia Water for about 1 mile and then turn right into Silwood Road (B383), signposted to Sunningdale Park. Then follow the directions above marked *

Exit M3 at Junction 3

Take the exit signposted Bracknell (A322) Pass a set of traffic lights and take the second turning on the left onto the A30 London/Staines/Heathrow. Follow this road for approximately 2 miles. After Sunningdale Railway Station take the first left turn onto Broomhall Lane (B383) signposted to Sunninghill/Ascot. Then follow this road (B383) and Larch Avenue can be found on the right hand side after climbing a hill (Rise Road). The main entrance to Sunningdale Park can be found after a short distance on the right hand side.



By Train:

Sunningdale station is 1½ miles from the venue and a 50 minute train journey direct from London Waterloo.

Championship Details

FIDE Open – Open to all players born before 1st January 1955. This event will be FIDE rated and the highest placed player not already qualified will qualify for the 2014 British Championships

The highest placed eligible player will receive the title of English Seniors Champion from the English Chess Federation.

Entry Fee

The entry fee is £50 per player.

Discounts

There is a £10 discount off of the entry fee for those players staying 3 nights or more at the venue (if booked with e2e4 Chess).

(W)GMs / (W)IMs may play free of any entry fee.

FMs play for half price entry fee.

Female players play for half price entry fee

A late entry fee of £5 will be payable on entries received after Sunday 6th April 2014. Entries may be accepted on the day subject to availability and payment of a £10 fee.

Refreshments

Tea, coffee, alcoholic and soft drinks, sandwiches, snacks etc will be available, as well as a fully licensed restaurant.
